
## Reject a Course, Substitute Another

While reviewing an encoded degree audit, you may notice a requirement is not yet met due to an outstanding grade:




However, looking at the bottom of the audit, I see another course with a grade that could be substituted:




1. First, I must reject the AUT18 ECON 572 course. I check the PSNAME to reject an elective, in the DARS exception site:
